Holocaust Remembrance Assembly

On 27 June, Michael Bibring addressed Longfield Academy, recounting his father's experiences with the Kindertransport during the Holocaust. Bibring detailed how his father, as a young boy, was one of the fortunate children rescued from Nazi-occupied territories and brought to safety in Britain. He shared emotional anecdotes of his father's journey, the separation from his family, and the challenges of adapting to a new life in a foreign country. Bibring's talk emphasised the courage of those who facilitated the Kindertransport and the lasting impact it had on his father's life and legacy.
